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Our Facilities

The Susan B. Anthony Recovery Center is located on a beautiful 5.5 acre campus in Pembroke Pines. We are the only residential treatment facility in Broward County, Florida allowing children to reside with their mothers while receiving services needed to transform their lives. Our program has the capacity to serve over 60 families in our residential apartments and provides a comprehensive array of services to the families including:

- Skilled PhD and Masters Level Therapists on staff for both women and their children
- Acupuncture, Hypnosis, Psychiatric Services, Nutrition, Nursing, Art Therapy, Quilting, and many other services
- On-site Gold Seal Accredited Childcare
- A safe, family oriented residential setting
- On-site 12 step groups
- Transportation available
- Parenting education
- Vocational and educational services
- CARF Accreditation (Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities)

Susan B. Anthony now accepts most major insurance providers.

- Individuals must be pre-approved by their insurance carrier. Most private insurance carriers are welcome and accepted.
- Admission staff will work with clients on benefit eligibility and approvals.
- Private pay options are also available for residential or outpatient treatment. Please call to discuss rates with the admissions staff.



Our Admission Requirements

- Clients must be 18 years or older.
- Clients must either be pregnant or a parent. It is not required that a child/children enter the program with the mother.
- All Clients must be clean from opiates and benzodiazepines, or enter a detoxification program prior to being admitted.
- If you are residing out of Broward County, Florida a telephone interview will be conducted for the screening and to complete the pre-entry evaluations.

I might check back in with Susan B. in another 10 years and maybe in the same exact point in my life, and that will be okay because just for today I did not pick up... Recovery is a beautiful thing.”
